Today was the second lesson in the DARE curriculum and it was about “Tobacco and You” The goals of this lesson are to help children develop a basic knowledge of tobacco and its harmful effects. Your child:

- Discussed warning labels on tobacco products
- Created their own warning label using the health facts discussed in class

Some suggested topics for you to discuss with your child are:

- How many 8th graders they thought used tobacco and why. What was the actual number?
- Some facts they learned about tobacco use.
- Why warning labels are on tobacco products and explain their warning label.
